CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgment that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules. PCV rules may be found at [www.ponyclubvic.org.au]
- The organizing committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- All refunds will incur a \$10 admin fee. No refunds after closing unless notified prior to ride time and a Veterinary or Medical Certificate supplied within 7 days of scratching.
- Competitors may ride more than one horse competitively subject to ballot of entries. Preferences will be based on listed order on entry form.
- PCV club member card, or verification form, must be presented at the event office before riding. Information must be accurate and rider onus applies subject to elimination, which will be enforced without exception
- Gear check is required before each phase and competitors must be present at least 15 minutes before each phase begins. Medical arm bands to be inspected at gear check and are to be worn in all phases. Grade 4, 5 & 6 riders may not wear stopwatches.
- **Competitor numbers** - the organizing committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Competitors may supply their own numbers. However, body numbers must be used for cross-country. Body numbers for grades 5&6 will be available at the event. **Riders in Grades 1-4 must provide a full-size number holder.** The smaller number holders used at Interschools events are not acceptable.
- Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in PCV Gear Rules. Spot checks may occur and incorrect helmet will mean elimination.
- Queries, protests, horse abuse and doping rules as per the PCV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
- All riders must be prepared to ride before the allocated time.
- Riders under eight years of age may not compete, horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
- Neither the organizing committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- Dogs prohibited without exception.
- Riders or spectators may be photographed or filmed by official photographers or local press. These images may be used in newsletters, flyers, websites or other promotional activities for the Central Zone of Pony Clubs or PCV.

Reminder: this is a Central Zone event. Each family required to nominate a volunteer helper, who is available without conflicting caring or grooming duties. Where possible, jobs will be of no longer than 2 hours duration. Penalty for non-compliance will be elimination (no ribbons or placing points).
