Many years ago it was a well known EA course, until the event stopped and it fell into disrepair. Several years ago the Meeniyon PC together with the Stony Creek Riding Club made the decision to invest considerable time and money to bring the course back to it's former glory. Meeniyon PC held a successful Grade 2 – 5 horse trials there in April this year and hope to purchase/build enough jumps to add grade 1 at next years horse trials. There are already several grade 1 jumps on the course.

**Conditions of Entry:** Entry is conditional upon acknowledgement that PCV rules apply, and acceptance of these conditions.

1. Entry Fee is \$32 per cross country entry, and \$18 for 4 pre-purchased showjumping training rounds. Entries will not be accepted without the entry fee.
2. For pony club members, PCV club member cards must be inspected at the event office before riding.
3. PCV members showjumping above their grading are required to fill in the [Liability Declaration Form](#)
4. **Open Riders**
  - a. Everybody fills in the [Liability Declaration Form](#)
  - b. \$10 per day Day Attendance Fee is due UNLESS you are a financial member\* of EV/EA; AHS; SHCA; AERA; an Interstate Pony Club; or can prove personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. **\*Must** produce proof.
  - c. Riders without adequate Insurance Cover pay \$10 for Liability Only cover for the duration of the event. (Not personal Medical) and complete the [Day Participant Waiver](#).  
***PCAV Insurance Policy specifically states anyone not following PCAV Rules may be left uninsured.***
5. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 will be deducted. Refunds before the closing date will also incur an admin fee of \$10.
6. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
7. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
8. Complying helmets must worn, please present your helmet for examination when checking in at the secretary's office.
9. Gear Check: required for all riders before each phase.
10. Medical Armbands: must be worn by all riders whilst mounted.
11. Horses must be at least four years of age, no stallions, colts or rigs.
12. PCAV Alcohol Policy applies.
13. Dogs and other pets are prohibited without exception.
14. Lungeing is not permitted at this competition.
15. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
16. Media and Digital Publication Consent: Riders / families who are involved or attending out Horse Trials may be photographed by official Photographers, local media or event organisers, these images may be used to promote the event in newsletters, flyers, websites and other promotional activities
17. Riding times will be advised via email
18. Any temporary yards used must of solid construction.
