**Sashes to Sixth Place Best - Dressage sash for each grade (must compete in all phases)**

**Pony Club Grades 1 to 5 including Grade 6 Combined Training and Open Sections Grades 1 to 4 (Open riders must be 16 years or over)**

Dressage tests –1C,2C, 3C, 4C ,5C and 6CT (Dressage test 5A ) (PCAV Tests FEB 2013) – Dressage arenas as per PCAV Cross Country and Show Jumping heights and spreads as per PCAV Horse Trials Rules.

**Conditions of Entry:** Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions.

1. Pony Club Horse Trials Entry Fee is \$35 per entry, Open section Entry Fee \$50 and Grade 5 CT \$15
2. **Open Riders**
  - a. Everybody fills in the [Liability Declaration Form](#)
  - b. \$10 Day Attendance Fee is due UNLESS you are a financial member\* of EV/EA; AHS; SHCA; AERA; an Interstate Pony Club; or can prove personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000.  
**\*Must produce proof.**
  - c. Riders without adequate Insurance Cover pay \$10 for Liability Only cover for the duration of the event. (Not personal Medical) and complete the [Day Participant Waiver](#).
  - d. PCAV club member cards must be inspected at the secretary's office.  
**PCAV Insurance Policy specifically states anyone not following PCAV Rules may be left uninsured.**
3. No refunds after closing date.
4. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
5. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
6. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of PCAV *Handbook of By-laws* multiple horse rules.
7. Complying helmets must worn, spot checks may occur.
8. Gear Check: required for all riders before each phase.
9. Medical Armbands: must be worn by all competitors.
10. Riders under eight years of age may not compete, horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
11. Competitor numbers – back numbers provided must be worn for all three phases. Bridle numbers may be worn in dressage and show jumping.
12. PCAV Alcohol Policy applies.
13. Dogs are prohibited without exception.
14. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCAV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
15. PCAV Lungeing Policy applies.
16. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.

The organising committee of the Lochard Pony Club reserves the right to cancel or postpone this event if it occurs on a day of extreme heat. (refer to PCAV guidelines for heat policy)
