Conditions of Entry:

1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that current PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules
2. PCV Gear Check Rules must be adhered to. All riders must have a gear check before each phase, PCV Gear Check Rules January 2018
Complying helmets must be worn.
 - ASSA3838 standard
 - EN1384 standard, made in 2015 or older
 - EN1384 standard plus the VG1 standard
 - VG1 standard
 - ASTHF1163 standard
 - ARB HS 2012 standard
 - PAS 015 BSI Kite marked
3. Open Riders;
 - Everyone needs to complete a Liability Declaration Form (Form available at www.eventsecretary.com.au/equestrian at time of entry, please download and hand the completed form in on competition day - No form no ride)
 - Participants need to pay \$10 Day Attendance Fee UNLESS they can provide proof that they are a current financial member of; Pony Club Association of Victoria (PCV), Equestrian Australia (EA), Horse Riding Clubs Association of Victoria (HRCV), Arab Horse Society of Australia (AHSA), Australian Endurance Riders Association (AERA), or can provide proof that they are covered by Public Liability Insurance Policy with a minimum of \$10,000,000**
 - Please bring proof of current membership to the office before riding
 - Riders without adequate insurance cover pay \$10 for Liability only cover for the duration of the event (not personal medical) and complete the Day Participant Waiver
 - PCV club member cards must be inspected at the Secretary's Office prior to competing
 - PCV Insurance Policy specifically states that anyone not following PCV may be left uninsured
4. **All refunds will incur a \$10 administration fee, no refunds after closing date unless notified prior to ride time and a Veterinary or Medical Certificate is supplied within 7 days of notification of scratching**
5. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition, divide any class, alter times, refuse entry with or without stating the reason
6. All PCV club member cards must be handed in to the Secretary's Office before riding
7. Competitors may ride more than one horse competitively, subject to ballot of entries, preferences will be based on listed order on entry form
8. Medical Armbands must be worn by all competitors
9. Queries, protests, horse abuse rules; as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws, January 2018
10. **NO DOGS ALLOWED**
11. Competitor numbers; Competitors may supply their own bridle or saddlecloth numbers for dressage and show jumping, competitors must supply their own back number holders, the organising committee will supply numbers, long hair must not obscure back numbers at any time
12. PCV Alcohol Policy applies
13. PCV Smoking Policy applies
14. Neither the organising committee of the competition nor PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property
15. Presentations will occur after scores have been posted for 30 minutes
16. Lunging is not permitted at this venue

Pony Club Cards: Any pony club member who does not present a valid PCV Card will need to ride in the Open section. It is your responsibility to ensure that your membership card is accurate and presented to the organising committee on the day.
