What is Pony Club Tetrathlon?

It involves four disciplines:

- **Shooting** – 10 metres to target with a laser device. (10-12 years – 7 metres)
- **Running** – 1000 to 3000 metres.
- **Riding** – Derby – 80-90cm jumps over approximately 600 metres.*
- **Swimming** – 10-12 years 100metres | 13-16 years 200metres | 17+ years 200metres.

I've never shot a gun and I don't own one?

That's ok, most members who start out competing in Tetrathlons have never shot a gun. A Laser gun clinic will also be held on Saturday 20th at 4pm in the Indoor Arena.

You must bring your own mount. Horses will not be supplied by the organizing Committee.
