

Hosting of the Junior Prince Philip Games National Championships 2018

Membership Fees 2018/2019

Tetrathlon –

A Policy will be developed to be developed for the use of PCV equipment in Clubs and Zones.

PCV has purchased 3 pistols and targets but does not yet own the computers required to complete the sets, these are currently borrowed from the Modern Pentathlon Victoria (MPV) equipment.

Kate Thompson (MPV) is the custodian of the PCV equipment as she has all the relevant qualifications plus the additional equipment required.

PCV will draw up a policy in consultation with Kate to allow Clubs & Zones to borrow the Tetrathlon Equipment.

There will be no hire fee however, the equipment must be in the hands of a PCV appointed custodian which may incur a fee for travel and accommodation and to have the State Coach in attendance.

Kate Thompson is currently the only person qualified to be in control of the pistols. The current program is being run and jointly funded by the partnership with Modern Pentathlon.

Rules for running introduction tetrathlon competitions at Clubs and Zone level will also be developed.

Rules Cross Country – Frangible Pins

Some Pony Club Courses are using frangible pins – this must be noted on the schedule with the scoring system explained.

11 penalty points must be deducted from the rider's score if the pin is activated.

Frangible pins are only required on box parallels on 1.10 courses

Motion:

“That Clubs using frangible pins on their cross-country course must state on their program that they will be using the Equestrian Victoria Penalties of 11 penalty points for an activated.”
